1 CAS Data Protection Regulations

Data protection

CAS Software AG aims to respect and protect your privacy. We have generally designed www.cas.de so that you can visit the website without being personally identifiable and without any personal information about you being disclosed. If you decide to disclose personal information to us, we undertake to treat it with great care.

Personal data

The term 'personal data' refers to items of information which can give indications as to the identity or private matters of an individual. It includes the person's correct name, address, telephone number and e-mail address. Based on the above definition, it does not include information which does not give indications as to the identity or private matters of an individual, such as the number of visitors to a website.

Gathering and use of personal data

The information provided by CAS Software AG is normally freely accessible. No personal registration is required. Personal information is gathered where necessary in order to perform relevant services. This is the case, for example, if you subscribe online to the CAS@WORK customer magazine, or if you request information material or obtain test software. We only use your personal data to enable us to provide you with the services you request.

Disclosure of data

CAS Software AG will treat your personal data in strict confidence, and as a matter of principle will not disclose it to third parties (except for partners of the CAS Group).

Consent

When you disclose your personal data to us, you thereby give your consent for us to store and use it within the constraints of the German Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz). The personal information you provide is accessible only to CAS Software AG and to its partners where appropriate. You can cancel your subscription to our customer magazine and e-mail newsletter, or withdraw your consent for us to store and use your personal data, at any time.

Changes to this statement

CAS Software AG reserves the right to change this Data Protection Statement at any time within the constraints of the applicable law.



Usage statistics

We collect statistical data on the use of our website in order to continually improve what we offer on it. To do so we use the services provided by etracker, econda, Webtrends, AddThis, WiredMinds and Google Analytics. This may involve the use of cookies and/or JavaScript and/or Flash. User profiles under pseudonyms are created from this data. The data is only collected and stored in pseudonymous form. The data is not used to personally identify users of the Website and is kept separate from data about the holder of the pseudonym. This ensures that no link can be established to the aforementioned log data or user profile data.

We use products and services from WiredMinds AG (www.wiredminds.de) to improve our marketing. Data is collected, processed and stored in pseudonymous form. Where possible, and where deemed sensible, the data is made completely anonymous. We may use cookies to this end. Cookies are small text files which are saved on your computer, and which recognize your internet browser the next time you access the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of our website can contain personal data, which is either recorded directly by WiredMinds themselves, or transmitted to them. WiredMinds use this data to create anonymous user profiles. Data collected in this way cannot be used to either: personally identify any users of our website, nor link them in any way with the holder of the pseudonym, without their express written consent. With regards to the recording of IP addresses, the last number block of the IP is deleted immediately after recording, which effectively makes the IP addresses anonymous. You may opt out of data recording, processing and storing at any time with future effect.
